Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with Club Welfare Officer, Joyce Clark (07867886231).

As a member of Osterley Cricket Club you are expected to abide by the following junior code of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit – cricket clothing, appropriate footwear and protective equipment including batting helmets for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager.
- Members must pay any fees for match day, training or events promptly.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke on club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Junior members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Junior members are only allowed to travel with their designated guardians/parents who the club is informed of.
- All junior members must abide by club policies and procedures while they are at the premises.
